**PLEASE NOTE:** Currently UMaine's health and safety protocol for on-campus visits requires individuals to wear a face covering only when indoors except when eating or drinking. We do not know if that same protocol will remain in place when Reunion is held on September 17th. The current protocol for Buchanan Alumni House, which is privately owned by the Alumni Association and Foundation and is not considered a UMaine facility, does not require face covering for individuals who are fully vaccinated for COVID-19. Those who are not fully vaccinated are expected to wear a face covering when inside Buchanan Alumni House, both as health and safety measures and out of respect for others. You will be asked to agree to abide by that protocol when registering to attend. You will also be asked to knowingly waive any legal claim or civil action you might have that could arise out of that circumstance and your attendance at this event.
